



Who is Fitzy Fox? Lesson

WRITING: SYNONYMS

Description:

An activity to learn about synonyms and to build vocabulary.

Australian Curriculum Links:

Year 1

Vocabulary: Understand the use of vocabulary in everyday contexts as well as a growing number of school contexts, including appropriate use of formal and informal terms of address in different contexts (ACELA1454)

Year 2

Vocabulary: Understand the use of vocabulary about familiar and new topics and experiment with and begin to make conscious choices of vocabulary to suit audience and purpose (ACELA1470)

Year 3

Vocabulary: Learn extended and technical vocabulary and ways of expressing opinion including modal verbs and adverbs (ACELA1484)

Lesson Outline:

Introduction: Read through the list of words from the story on the left hand side and elicit meanings. Ask students to put the words in context.

Body: Independently or in pairs, students connect the words. Students can choose 3 words to use in sentences or in a story.

Conclusion: Share sentences with the class.
